CODE OF CONDUCT

QMCC has been established to provide an environment where God is glorified and where Christian Character and behavior are the rule rather than the exception. Therefore the following policies have been instituted by the QMCC Board of Directors.

These guidelines must be respected and observed by any individual and group using and/or attending QMCC. Abuse of these guidelines will not be tolerated.

The property and facilities of QMCC must be respected. Willful damage and destruction of QMCC property and facilities will not be tolerated. The property boundaries and neighbors of QMCC should be respected. The property and well being of others must be respected. Acts of bullying, hazing, sabotage, and belittlement will not be accepted.

Be wise and safe when hiking on the mountains. Teenagers and children should always be accompanied by a responsible adult when hiking. Counselors must accompany children at all times during the day.

The swimming pool may only be used as the camp manager dictates. Swimming is not permitted without the supervision of a lifeguard. Showers must be taken before swimming and cover ups must be worn to and from the pool.

Proper dress must be observed at all times. All clothing, including shorts, must be modest length. Tank tops, halter tops, muscle shirts, and low cut clothing is not allowed. A cover up must be worn to and from the pool. Clothing with obscene or suggestive printing is not tolerated.

Possession or use of alcohol, tobacco in any form, and/or drug paraphernalia is absolutely prohibited. Those who possess or use any controlled substance will be expelled from QMCC by local authorities.

Firearms, knives weapons and fireworks are not allowed on QMCC grounds

- _ Tennis Shoes & Flip-Flops or Sandals. (There are times when you will be involved in activities that will require tennis shoes or some other type of “active” shoes. Flip-flops are handy for walking to and from the pool, and even for showering.)
- _ Laundry bag for dirty clothes (no laundry facilities available)
- _ Swim suit and cover-up
- _ Sunscreen
- _ Flashlight
- _ Mosquito repellent
- _ Camera (optional)
- _ Personal sports equipment (optional)
